

Operating- and assembly instructions for safety cabinets



Dear Customer,

Many thanks for your decision of buying the safety cabinet of Burg-Wächter.

These instructions shall describe operating and assembly of the safety cabinets.

Opening the safety cabinet:

- Please open the door according to the attached operating instructions of the lock itself (electronic or key lock) and pull the door open.

Closing the safety cabinet:

- Shut the door. **Please pay attention that nothing is getting caught in the door (danger for bruise) !!**
- Close the door according to the attached operating instructions of the lock itself (electronic or key lock).

Assembly:

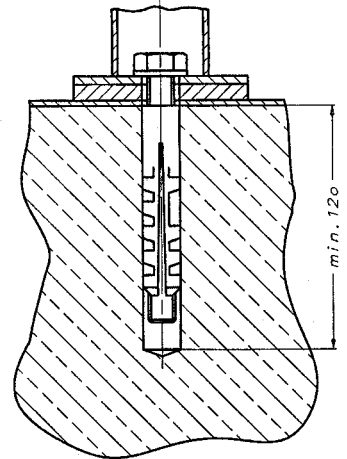
The safety cabinet obtains its required protective function only by fixing it at a solid part of a building. Please **only** use the designated anchorage points inside the cabinet (wall / floor) to reach the necessary stationary fixing, as follows:

- In case of floor fixing drill the safe body open with a 10 mm steel drill from the outside to the inside, in case of wall fixing from the inside to the outside at the position where a hole is already.
- Then place the safety cabinet in its final position.
- With a 10 mm stone drill bore through the pre-marked position into the wall or floor. Pay attention to the existing maximum ground height and to potential heating pipes, electric cables, etc. in the wall / floor.
- Remove the cabinet and enlarge the already drilled hole to 14 mm diameter. Clean the hole and then place a plug (Fischer M10S or similar) into the hole.

Please pay attention, that depending on different types of floors and walls special dowels are recommended to possibly increase the effectiveness of the anchoring.

The gripping length of the plug has to be placed in a solid wall or concrete. In the case of a floating floor, we suggest to extend the length of the hole by the height of the floating floor including the thereunder insulation. In this case use a longer screw with a min. resistance of 8.8.

- Place the safety cabinet again in its final position and screw it tight.
- For safety cabinets with fire resistance grade LFS 30 P all anchorage holes have to be closed with screw caps filled with insulation material.



Important Notice:

- After a burglary or attempted burglary, after a fire as well as in case of any inappropriate operation of construction and function the safety cabinet loses its certification which is exposed in the inner side of the door. In such a case, please contact your nearest Burg-Wächter Service Partner.
- Safety cabinets of this series do not require any regular maintenance. In case of failure after a longer utilisation period please contact your nearest Burg-Wächter Service Partner.
- This safety cabinet loses its factory guarantee with the attempt of "self-help". Please never make any own repair attempts without consulting the Burg-Wächter service engineer!
